Helping Housebuilders Replace Assumption with Evidence

For housebuilders, uncertainty on site quickly becomes expensive. Decisions involving tens of thousands of pounds are often based on incomplete information, infrequent surveys, or assumptions.

Working with developers including Taylor Wimpey, Barratt Redrow, Bellway, Miller Homes and Vistry Group, Drone Surveying combines accurate drone surveys with practical Digital Value Engineering, helping technical, engineering and commercial teams work from the same trusted information.

Digital Value Engineering, Not Just Drone Surveys

Our role as a Digital Value Engineering partner increasingly sets Drone Surveying apart. Rather than simply supplying survey outputs, we help teams interpret changing site conditions and make faster, evidence-based decisions on earthworks, programme risk and valuation.

Through repeatable surveys, clients receive cut and fill analysis, stockpile volumetrics, progress tracking, CAD-ready terrain data, and historical comparisons. This gives teams clearer visibility of site conditions and greater confidence in planning, materials management, and programme delivery.

Delivering Measurable Commercial Value

Clients have reported up to 20% reductions in aggregate and haulage costs, while larger earthworks projects have delivered savings worth tens of thousands of pounds through reduced rework, improved cut and fill balancing.

Historical survey records minimise unnecessary repeat surveys while supporting planning requirements, change management, and commercial accountability.

Fast, Accurate and Trusted at Scale

Quality, speed, and reliability sit at the heart of our service.

Survey data is typically available within 24 hours through a secure online platform, giving teams fast access to accurate information.

In 2025 alone, Drone Surveying completed more than 1,265 surveys across UK developments. Volumetric reporting is typically delivered to within $\pm 2\%$ accuracy, improving confidence in planning, valuations, and material management.

Safer, Smarter Site Operations

Drone surveying significantly reduces the need for surveyors and site teams to access hazardous live-site environments, including unstable stockpiles, difficult terrain and areas around moving plant. Operating under CAA PDRA01 permissions with robust planning and risk assessment processes, Drone Surveying supports safer decision-making while helping clients meet CDM responsibilities.

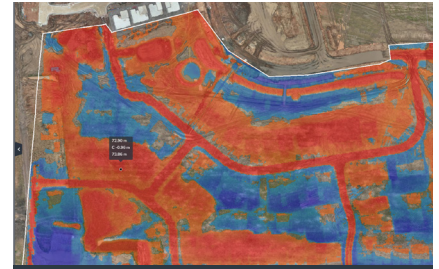
Clearer visibility of cut and fill requirements reduces unnecessary material movement, avoidable haulage and waste, helping lower both project cost and environmental impact through better earthworks planning.

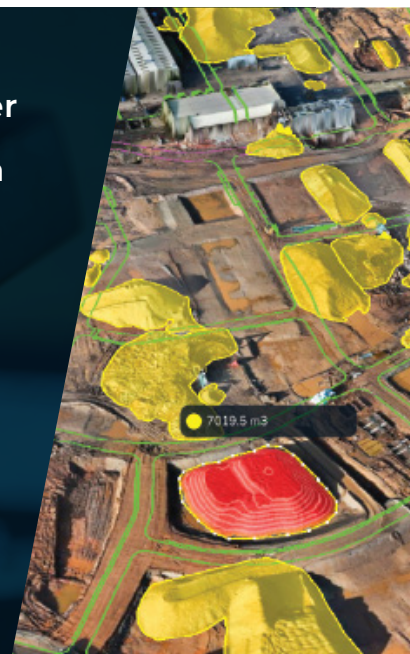

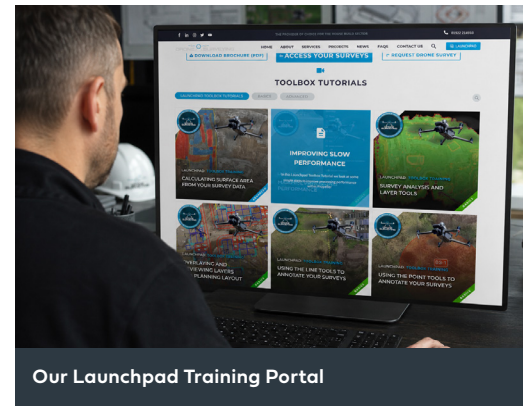

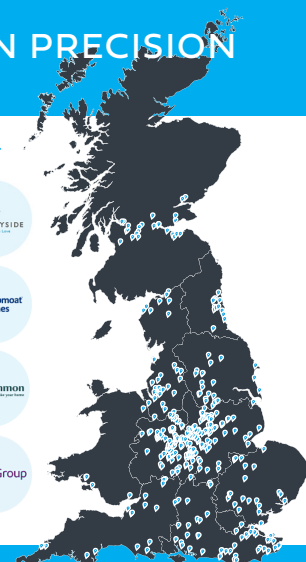
